


TEMPE CENTER FOR THE ARTS UNIT FORMAT



The Tempe Center for the Arts' online curriculum is an archive of unit plans designed in conjunction with each of its exhibitions since its opening in 2007. All units posted since Arizona adopted the latest Visual Arts Standards address a grade-specific standards for each of the four art processes.

Each unit consists of four detailed lesson plans, complete with instructional PowerPoints and worksheets, plus images and artist statements from the exhibition.

The first lesson introduces the broad theme of the unit **CONNECTING** everyday artifacts and artworks to the students' knowledge and experience.

Lesson Two outlines a gallery activity that engages students in **RESPONDING** to two works from the exhibition. The lesson can be completed in the gallery or, because reproductions incorporated into the worksheet, teachers can also use them in their classrooms.

The third and fourth lessons are designed to address **CREATING** and **PRESENTING** standards specific to a specific elementary grade and to a specific secondary grade.
